HOUSING AND TRANSPORTATION

Employer-owned or employer-arranged housing description:

- Noah's Ark has a brand new 400 bed dormitory for employees.
- It is located onsite and contains a full kitchen and lounge area on the first floor.
- Onsite laundry, employee cafeteria, and retail store are also available for employee use.
- Rooms will have up to 4 people per unit with a shared bathroom in the unit.
- Each room will also have a microwave, refrigerator, and a storage closet for each student that has the ability to be locked.
- · There is also a cafeteria next to the dorm that students may purchase meals at as well a convenient store that has the essentials for purchase.
- Noah's Ark does have other housing options available upon student request.
- · Students are also able to find housing on their own if they choose.

ONSITE AMENITIES

WiFi: Yes. Internet is available at no additional cost to student.

Phone Service: Yes. Wi-Fi is available within the dorm and there is a phone for student use for emergencies.

Kitchen facilities: Yes. Full kitchen is available with multiple stoves, ovens, microwaves and seating areas. Students are expected to maintain and clean their dishes/kitchen after they are done using the facilities.

Each unit will have its own bathroom to be shared among roommates.

International Employee Information

Getting to the U.S. and Wisconsin Dells

All flights should be scheduled close to, but BEFORE your actual DS2019 start date. NOT more than 4 days before. Keep in mind you can NOT start working before your actual DS2019 start date, but we can get you moved in to housing and have your Orientation completed. Return flights, or plans to travel when done working, should be made at least a day AFTER your DS2019 end date. We DO expect you to honor your contract and work THROUGH your actual DS2019 end date.

We suggest that you exchange some of your money for U.S. currency at O'Hare aiport if you don't already have some of our currency. In MOST cases it will be up to 2-3 weeks to receive your first paycheck. PLEASE make sure you bring enough money to survive for those weeks including the cost of travel from airport, food, items you may want for housing and possible purchase of a bicycle. It is highly suggested that you bring \$1,000 to \$1,500. You may pay with cash or by credit/debit card for your housing deposit UPON ARRIVAL to the Noah's Ark HR Office located at 311 East Lake Avenue at the time of check in.

The Housing Deposit is \$200 with a possible refund of up to \$150 IF you stay through your contract date AND your housing is left CLEAN with no damages. Your housing deposit MUST be paid prior to moving into housing. NO EX-CEPTIONS. Please plan ahead.

Most often, international employees fly in at O'Hare International Airport in Chicago, about 3 hours from Wisconsin Dells. It is up to you to plan how to get to Wisconsin Dells. Most students come by Amtrak train (<u>www.amtrak.com</u>) or Greyhound bus ($\underline{www.greyhound.com}$). Both can be accessed in Chicago from the airport and both come to Wisconsin Dells. Follow your travel plans and do NOT take rides from individuals at the airport that may offer you a ride. You do NOT know these people and we have NOT sent them!

From Chicago O'Hare Airport to get to the Greyhound bus terminal OR Amtrak train station: Arriving at the International Terminal 5 you will first need to take the Airport Transit System to Terminal 3. Follow the CTA Blue Line El Train signs. Choose to either ride the Greyhound Bus or ride the Amtrak train to Wisconsin Dells before you leave home. Google directions for either and obtain detailed information for getting to the station you choose. General directions follow, but be sure to check for any updates, costs, etc.

To the Greyhound Bus Station: Get off the CTA Blue Line train and exit the station. Walk one block South on Clinton Street to Harrison Street. Go right on Harrison Street. The Downtown Chicago Greyhound Bus Station will be one block ahead at 630 West Harrison. Be sure to look for scheduled times beforehand at www.greyhound.com. The Greyhound bus will drop you off in downtown Wisconsin Dells. Depending on your arrival date, there are 1 or 2 buses that come to Wisconsin Dells each day. One has a morning departure, and the other is in the afternoon. Please be sure to look at the departure times/costs before you leave your home country.

To the Amtrak Train Station: Get off the CTA Blue Line train and exit the station. Walk a short distance east on the ramp. Turn left on S. Clinton Street. Walk 0.16 mile North on S. Clinton Street. Walk straight on Union Station walkway. Turn right on Union Station Clinton/Jackson. Walk a short distance North on Union Station Clinton/Jackson. Turn right on Union Station Walkway. Walk a short distance east on Union Station Walkway. Arrive at the Amtrak Station. Total walking is 0.32 miles. Be sure to look for scheduled times/costs at www.amtrak.com. The train will arrive in downtown Wisconsin Dells about 6:00 PM. Again, pre-plan as much as you can before your arrival in the U.S. so that all things go smoothly.







*Please TRY to plan your arrival time in Wisconsin Dells during the day as much as possible. IF you must arrive in the evening, (after 5:00 PM), please e-mail us your planned arrival day and time so we can make accommodations as needed

Once you arrive in Wisconsin Dells there are usually several taxi services that sit at the train station or bus stop. They are the common mode of transportation in Wisconsin Dells. The top of their car or sides of their vans will say "taxi". You can call for a taxi service if no one is at the station/stop. Taxi cost will depend on how many people are riding to our location.

Tell the taxi driver to take you to the Noah's Ark HR Office at 311 East Lake Avenue. You will, in most cases, be admitted to your housing unit where you will stay for the summer upon your arrival. Once again, if you plan to arrive after 5pm, please notify us so we can make arrangements. Your orientation will be the following day.

PLEASE AVOID arriving in Wisconsin Dells from May 20 through May 23, as much as possible. There is a LARGE Car Show event held in town, and this weekend is one of the busiest in Wisconsin Dells. If you plan to arrive during these dates, please email heather.wagner@palaceenter- tainment.com. The weekend will be your own to explore and get to know the city. We will get you signed up for orientation on Monday morning so you can begin work.



Noah's Ark will assist students in filling out the Social Security application form as well as provide transportation to the Social Security Office. Students will be signed up for a Social Security visit during orientation. Cost is approximately \$15 per student to the Social Security Office. Cost is subject to change based on Taxi rates.

Grooming Requirements:

- Females may have one piercing in their ear and visible tattoos are allowed as long as they are not deemed offensive.
- Males may NOT have any piercings. Visible tattoos are allowed as long as they are not deemed offensive. Facial hair is allowed as well as it is WELL maintained. If it is not well kept, employee will be asked to go home and shave before being allowed to work for the day.
- · All employees should maintain a high level of hygiene and shower on a daily basis.

APPLICABLE COMPANY POLICIES

All employees should expect to clean in some aspect. We work as a team to keep the park clean and cleaning of general work stations and areas is a requirement for all departments. We are a completely outdoor waterpark and employees should expect to work in various weather conditions. This includes cooler weather, hot weather, as well as rainy weather. Cold/Rain weather uniform pieces are available for purchase.

Cell phones are allowed ONLY in the break rooms, out of guest view. We strive to provide excellent customer service to our guests and want to give them our full attention when we are visible to them. Repeated use of cell phones outside of break room areas may result in termination.

Smoking is allowed in the employee parking lot, out of guest view. Employees are required to punch out (unpaid breaks) if they choose to smoke. Smoking is NOT permitted anywhere inside housing locations.

Scheduling is done by department and varies based on time of season. Students should request time off two weeks in advance and note that it is NOT guaranteed. Long trips should be done after the work period is done, and not expect extended time off during their job contract dates. Employees are expected to show up on time for all schedule shifts. Excessive unexcused absences and no-call, noshows to shifts will result in termination.
